### **Worker injury claims**

Suppose you have been injured at work or have sustained or aggravated a medical condition in the course of your employment. In that case, you may have access to entitlements under the workers' compensation scheme. Lawyers may be able to assist you with your claim for compensation under a No Win - No Fee claims process.

### **Wills, probate and estate planning**

HSUWA members are able to complete an online standard Will at no cost.

Lawyers will help you, at a discounted rate, if your matter is complicated and requires a non-standard Will to be drawn up.

Lawyers can also advise you with preparing powers of attorney and enduring powers of guardianship, administration of deceased estate, superannuation and death benefits, and disputes.

### **Steps to access legal services**

#### Step 1

Contact the HSUWA (9328 5155 or [unions@hsuwa.com.au](mailto:unions@hsuwa.com.au)) and ask the Enquiries Officer for a referral to one of our partners.

#### Step 2

The Enquiries Officer will ask for your name and contact details. You will also be asked what type of legal services you require so that you can be referred to the appropriate lawyer.

#### Step 3

Once your matter is referred to one of our partners, one of its lawyers or representatives will call you to discuss your legal needs in greater detail, with access to discounted costs for services.
